Welcome prospective Pinnacle vendor!

Thank you for your interest in doing business with Pinnacle Entertainment, Inc. (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Pinnacle" or "the Company"). Pinnacle Entertainment, Inc. is a publicly held company, whose stock is traded on the New York Stock Exchange. The Company, which is headquartered in Las Vegas, is a leading diversified, multi-jurisdictional developer, owner and operator of gaming entertainment facilities. It owns and operates six properties in the United States located in southeastern Indiana; Reno, Nevada; Bossier City, Lake Charles and New Orleans, Louisiana; and St. Louis City, Missouri. The Company has an additional casino under construction in St. Louis County, subject to the final approval of the Missouri Gaming Commission. In addition, the Company has purchased 18 contiguous acres in the heart of Atlantic City, New Jersey, which it plans to develop. The Company also operates several small casinos in Argentina and the Bahamas.

As a member of the gaming industry, the Company and its vendors must comply with certain regulatory and licensing requirements imposed upon them by local gaming regulatory authorities. This Vendor Registration Packet is being provided to you, so that Pinnacle may comply with those requirements. **All vendors are required to complete a Corporate Vendor Packet.** Please note that this information may be shared with any gaming regulatory agency having jurisdiction over Pinnacle or any of its affiliates and subsidiaries.

Any licensing information contained herein is provided merely as a courtesy and should not be taken as legal advice regarding your obligations. It is the **VENDOR'S RESPONSIBILITY** to verify its licensing obligations in all applicable jurisdictions. If required, the vendor is responsible, at its sole cost and expense, to apply and maintain any and all permits or licenses required by any applicable gaming agency in order to conduct business with Pinnacle. Failure to maintain appropriate permit/licensing in any jurisdiction could result in **automatic termination** of the contract. Pinnacle is committed to providing equal opportunity for all vendors.

Additional forms and licensing requirements vary by location of the Pinnacle property. The information below provides instructions for vendor registration in each state Pinnacle currently conducts business. In addition, contact information for each state's gaming regulatory agency is provided should you need further information. For any questions please direct your inquiries to the Corporate Procurement Office at (702) 784-7777.

Conducting Business with the Pinnacle Corporate Offices

The Company has the responsibility to ensure that it and its affiliates do business only with suppliers, purveyors and other providers of goods and services who are Suitable Persons. Accordingly, all vendors conducting business with the Pinnacle Corporate Offices and who are anticipated to provide **over \$250,000** in goods or services during the fiscal year will be subject to a review for evidence of good reputation in the business community.

A vendor packet (as described above) will be required along with the following: (i) the licensing or approval by any Gaming Authority or by any other governmental or professional licensing authority (ii) favorable information generally available to the Company from the business or professional community; or (iii) information derived from prior relationships or dealings between such Persons and the Company or its Affiliates.

Any vendor who provides **over \$2,000,000**, goods or services will be subject to a review by the Corporate Compliance Committee. If requested, the vendor shall promptly provide Pinnacle Entertainment Inc.'s Compliance Committee, with all information reasonably required by Pinnacle and its Compliance Committee with respect to the vendor and its Affiliates' officers, directors, key employees and shareholders, financial condition, litigation, indictments, criminal proceedings and the like in which they are or may be involved, if any, in form and substance required by Pinnacle ("Requested Information") in order for Pinnacle to determine that the Requested Information does not disclose any fact which might adversely affect, in any manner, any gaming licenses or permits held by Pinnacle, Pinnacle or any of their affiliates, or the current stature of Pinnacle, Pinnacle or its affiliates with any gaming commission, board or similar regulatory authority. In the event the vendor fails to provide the Requested Information promptly, or if the information provided with respect to the vendor or its respective affiliates in

the reasonable opinion of Pinnacle or its Compliance Committees might adversely affect the gaming or liquor licenses or permits held by Pinnacle or Pinnacle or its affiliates or the current stature of Pinnacle or Pinnacle or its affiliates with any gaming commission, board, or similar governmental or regulatory agency, then Pinnacle shall have the right to immediately terminate this Agreement with no further obligations or liability to the vendor by Pinnacle. This is a continuing obligation of the vendor upon request of Pinnacle's Compliance Committee.

Any vendor entering into a contract that is executed at the Corporate level on behalf of the Pinnacle operating properties will be required to comply with the regulations in **all** applicable jurisdictions. The Corporate Procurement Office can advise you whether your good or services will be used at any of Pinnacle's subsidiaries.

Conducting Business in the State of Louisiana

Louisiana State Permit Requirements

The Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of the State Police Riverboat Gaming Division, as provided in the State of Louisiana Administrative Code 42:2108, requires that all suppliers and/or vendors of goods and services to the Louisiana Gaming Industry, file a permit application, along with the appropriate fee, **and obtain approval** preceding any business transaction exceeding permit thresholds.

All **non-gaming suppliers** of goods and/or services that expect gross sales to exceed \$200,000 during a calendar year sold directly to the Louisiana Gaming Industry, are required to complete a Louisiana Non-Gaming Supplier Permit Application. **In order to facilitate compliance with Louisiana law, no business activity will be conducted by Pinnacle with any vendor whose gross sales exceed \$150,000 during the calendar year until permit approval by the Riverboat Gaming Division.**

All **gaming** suppliers of goods and/or services such as gaming devices and/or equipment must file an application **regardless** of their expected gross sales to the Louisiana Gaming Industry.

For questions concerning the Riverboat Gaming Application, contact the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of the State Police Riverboat Gaming Division at 225-295-8450.

Vendor Registration Requirements

All Vendors providing goods and services to Pinnacle's Louisiana Properties need to complete and return one copy of each of the following forms:

- 1) Vendor Registration Form
- 2) Affidavit of Business Ownership
- 3) Affidavit of Women/Minority Ownership
- 4) Vendor Compliance Acknowledgment
- 5) W-9

As part of the vendor registration packet, certification of minority owned, women owned, and Louisiana based business is required. The definition for these types of businesses is as follows:

Minority Business – A business which is at least 51% owned by one or more minority individuals domiciled in Louisiana who also control and operate the business. "Control" in this context means exercising the power to make policy decisions. "Operate" in this context means being actively involved in the day-to-day management of the business. In the case of publicly-owned business, at least 51% of the stock must be owned by one or more minority individuals domiciled in Louisiana who control and operate the business.

Those individuals to be defined as minorities must be citizens of the United States (or lawfully admitted permanent residents) and are either African American, Asian American (or Pacific islander), native American (or Alaskan Native), Hispanic American, and any other minority recognized by the Gaming Control Board.

Female Business – A business that is at least 51% owned by one or more women who are citizens of the United States, domiciled in Louisiana, and who also control and operate the business. This means that these individuals must be actively involved in the day-to-day management of the business and must exercise the power to make policy decisions.

Louisiana Business, Louisiana Company or Louisiana Corporation – A business, company or corporation which is at least 51% owned by one or more Louisiana domiciled individuals who also control and operate the business. “Control” in this context means exercising the power to make policy decisions. “Operate” in this context means being actively involved in the day-to-day management of the business. In the case of any publicly-owned business, at least 51% of the stock must be owned by one or more individuals domiciled in Louisiana who control and operate the business.

Conducting Business within the State of Missouri

State of Missouri Vendor Requirements

The state of Missouri **does not** require vendors of **non-gaming products** or services to be licensed by the state. Any vendor expected to be paid **over \$100,000** within a 12 month period will require a background check to be conducted by Pinnacle's Compliance Organization. The Company does not conduct background checks on publicly traded companies, government agencies, utilities, or financial institutions. Questions regarding the background check process may be directed to the Pinnacle Corporate Compliance Department at 775-345-8748.

A **supplier's license is required** for any company or individual that provides **gaming related** equipment devices, services or supplies to a licensed riverboat gambling operator.

Vendor Registration Requirements

All Vendors providing goods and services to Pinnacle's Missouri Properties need to complete and return one copy of each of the following forms:

- 2) Affidavit of Business Ownership
- 3) Affidavit of Women/Minority Ownership
- 4) Vendor Compliance Affidavit
- 5) W-9

Vendors expected to be paid over \$100,000, in addition to the documents required above need to complete and return one copy of each of the following forms:

- 1) Vendor Information Form (Exceeding \$100K)
- 2) Release Form

As part of the vendor registration packet, certification of minority owned, women owned, and Missouri based business is required. The definition for these types of businesses is as follows:

Minority Business – A business which is at least 51% owned by one or more minority individuals who also control and operate the business. . In the case of publicly-owned business, at least 51% of the stock must be owned by one or more minority individuals who control and operate the business.

Those individuals to be defined as minorities must be citizens of the United States (or lawfully admitted permanent residents) and are either African American, Asian American (or Pacific islander), native American (or Alaskan Native), Hispanic American, and any other minority recognized by the Gaming Control Board.

Female Business – A business that is at least 51% owned by one or more women who are citizens of the United States and who also control and operate the business. This means that these individuals must be actively involved in the day-to-day management of the business and must exercise the power to make policy decisions.

Missouri Based Business, Missouri Company or Missouri Corporation – A business, company or corporation which is at least 51% owned by one or more individuals who also control and operate the business. "Control" in this context means exercising the power to make policy decisions. "Operate" in this context means being actively involved in the day-to-day management of the business. In the case of any publicly-owned business, at least 51% of the stock must be owned by one or more individuals domiciled in Missouri who control and operate the business.

Conducting Business within the State of New Jersey

State of New Jersey Vendor Requirements

For **non-gaming** related products or services, prior to the purchase of any goods or services, all vendors must first register with the New Jersey Casino Control Commission. Once registered, the New Jersey Casino Control Commission will add a vendor to the list of the Commission's active/approved vendors and assign the vendor an identification number.

After you have been deemed an approved vendor, the New Jersey Casino Control Commission will monitor all disbursements between the vendor and a member of the casino industry. If the vendor transacts \$150,000 or more in business with one casino or \$500,000 with more than one casino within any twelve (12) month period, the Casino Control Commission will require the vendor to complete an application for a non-gaming Casino Service Industry license. Additionally, an enterprise which has not reached one of these thresholds may still be requested to file a license application based upon other standards described in the regulations [N.J.A.C. 19:51-1.2A].

Vendors that sell products or services that are **gaming related** must file an application with the Casino Control Commission prior to conducting any business. Vendor Registration Requirements

Pinnacle requires a vendor packet to be completed **PRIOR** to starting work and/or no later than 20 days after an agreement is entered into in addition to all requirements outlined by the New Jersey Gaming Commission.

All Vendors providing goods and services to Pinnacle's New Jersey Properties need to complete and return one copy of each of the following forms:

- 1) Pinnacle's Corporate Vendor Registration Form
- 2) State of New Jersey Registration Form
- 3) W-9

Conducting Business Within the State of Indiana

State of Indiana Vendor Requirements

Suppliers of gaming equipment, devices, and any other products or services directly related to gaming operations or affect the flow of money to an Indiana riverboat gambling operation are required to be licensed by the Indiana Gaming Commission. In addition, the Commission has traditionally required that suppliers of gaming equipment repair services, security systems or services, and surveillance systems to be licensed. For additional information please contact the Indiana Gaming Commission at (317) 233-0046.

The Commission **does not** typically license vendors of **non-gaming** related products.

The Indiana Department of Administration, Minority and Women's Business Enterprises Division is authorized to certify minority and women-owned businesses in the state and maintains a list of certified enterprises (i.e., MBEs and WBEs) for the commission. The IDOA may assist the commission in determining compliance with these regulations.

Vendor Registration Requirements

All Vendors providing goods and services to Pinnacle's Indiana Property need to complete and return one copy of each of the following forms:

- 1) Vendor Registration Form
- 2) Affidavit of Business Ownership
- 3) Affidavit of Women/Minority Ownership
- 4) W-9

As part of the vendor registration packet, certification of minority owned, women owned, and Indiana based business is required. The definition for these types of businesses is as follows:

Minority Business – A business which is at least 51% owned by one or more minority individuals who also control and operate the business. In the case of publicly-owned business, at least 51% of the stock must be owned by one or more minority individuals domiciled in Indiana who control and operate the business. In the state of Indiana, the owner of a for profit minority or women owned business does NOT have to be domiciled in the state of Indiana to qualify for M/WBE. Only Non-profit minority or women owned organizations have to be headquartered in Indiana.

Those individuals to be defined as minorities must be citizens of the United States (or lawfully admitted permanent residents) and are either African American, Asian American (or Pacific islander), native American (or Alaskan Native), Hispanic American, and any other minority recognized by the Indiana Gaming Commission.

Female Business – A business that is at least 51% owned by one or more women who are citizens of the United States who also control and operate the business. This means that these individuals must be actively involved in the day-to-day management of the business and must exercise the power to make policy decisions.

Conducting Business Within The Bahamas

There are no registration or permit requirements for vendors of **non-gaming** products and services within the Bahamas. Manufacturers and suppliers of **gaming related** equipment and services need to be approved by the Gaming Board and Hotel Corporation of the Bahamas. **INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING A NEW JERSEY VENDOR REGISTRATION
FORM (VRF)**

A VRF being filed with the New Jersey Casino Control Commission must be typewritten. Provide the requested information in every field. The majority of the questions are self explanatory; however, the following instructions should be utilized in the completion of certain items.

Item 1: "Enterprise" shall be defined to include any legal entity, including but not limited to: corporation, association, operation, firm, partnership, trust, sole-proprietorship or other form of business. Provide all names under which the enterprise currently conducts business.

Item 3: Provide the enterprise's mailing address and/or the address that is serving the casino. Post office boxes will only be accepted if an actual street address is also provided. County names are required only for enterprises that are located in New Jersey. Should the enterprise be located in a foreign country or U.S. possession list this name in the field designated as "state".

Item 4: Provide a specific description of the non-gaming business that your casino will conduct with the enterprise.

Item 7: Provide the enterprise's Federal Employer Identification number if one has been assigned by the Internal Revenue Service. If the enterprise is a sole-proprietorship and does not have such a number, the sole-proprietor should enter his or her Social Security Number.

Item 9: For each person acting in the described capacity (any company representative having direct interaction in this transaction), provide a complete name, residence (street) address, and date of birth. Post office boxes cannot be accepted.

Item 10: For each entity or person directly owning more than 5% of the enterprise, provide the percentage of ownership held, a complete name, street address (home address if a person), and date of birth (if a person). Post office boxes cannot be accepted.

- If the total percentage of ownership listed does not equal 100%, and no one person nor entity owns more that 5% of the remaining percentage, please state as follows: "Of the remaining _%, no one person nor entity owns more that 5%."
- If the company is publicly traded on the New York Stock Exchange, please state this.



Vendor Insurance Requirements

If the goods and/or services which you intend to provide to Pinnacle Entertainment Casinos and Properties require that you or your company representative enter onto our properties for the fulfillment of your company business, it is required that you provide us with proof of general liability insurance coverage as well as worker's compensation coverage equal to, or in excess of, the minimum limits required by the state our property is located. It shall be required that you provide to our property with a certificate of insurance evidencing these insurance coverage and that our property be listed as a certificate holder under the said policy so as to receive notice of cancellation.
